Date of Immigration	Jun/Jul 1845 arriving at New York
Description	Louis William (1822-1911) was a music teacher who followed his brother Heinrich to Maryland, who was himself a professor in music at Mount St. Mary's College, Emmitsburg, Maryland. Louis eventually purchased what later was known as the Dielman Inn in New Windsor, Maryland (see Time's Crossroads: the History of New Windsor, MD by Frank Batavick.)
