Description	This family made their way to Hancock County, Mississippi shortly after arriving and Franz/Frank passed away from yellow fever in 1870, before the 1870 Census. While most of the family remained in Mississippi, Frank Jr made his way back to New Orleans and raised his family there, he was a baker by trade. Via this Mississippi line of the family, we arrive at two brothers who became crewmembers of cargo ships originally working for the United Fruit Company.
