Description	Adam and Gustav were likely cousins, Adam was the son of Adam Dillmann and Juliana Muller while Gustav was the son of Jakob Dillman and Katherine Albert. They migrated together on the ship Southwark from Antwerp arriving in New York in Mar 1897. Adam settled in Lowell, Massachusetts and later Hartford, Connecticut while Gustav returned to Germany and was part of the Bavarian army in World War I.
