Date of Immigration	August Dellmann was naturalized on 3 Nov 1888 at the Circuit Court of Milwaukee, Wisconsin noting that he entered the US in Jun 1880. In an application for an Emergency Passport in Sep 1914, August noted he arrived in the US from Liverpool on 1 May 1880 and lived 34 years uninterrupted in Milwaukee.
Description	The 2 <sup>nd</sup> generation of the family were saloon keepers in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Arthur practiced the trade of machinist.  Arthur had several brothers baptized, married in Westfalen (North Rhineland-Westphalia) including Heinrich Wilhelm (b. 1833), Carl August (b.ca. 1836), Ludwig (b. 1841)
Facts	August Dellmann was born 10 Nov 1846, died 3 Feb 1920 according to his tombstone in Oak Creek, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin. August's baptism record indicated he was baptised on 28 Nov 1846 at the Evangelisch church in Wengern, Westfalen, Prussia, the son of Henrich Peter Dellmann and Maria Catharina Rueping.
