Date of Immigration	26 May 1871
Description	Dillmann family who migrated to Baltimore, Maryland in at least 3 waves. Were originally thought to have come from Berlin, but originated in Prussian held (post Napoleonic Wars) Rhineland-Pfalz, village of Sohren. First generation took up the occupation of pavers for the City of Baltimore and were buried in Most Holy Redeemer Cemetery (Roman Catholic).
Facts	Mathias Dillmann was born 3 Dec 1851 (tombstone) and died 31 Dec 1901.
