Facts	Benjamin appears in the 1881 UK Census for Melbourne as being 4 years old (b.ca. 1877) along with his parents, Samuel and Sarah Dallman and several siblings. His baptism record notes his name as Samuel Benjamin, baptised 11 Mar 1877 at Melbourne, Derby, England.
