Date of Immigration	Bernice Delmon arrived in New York from Liverpool, England on the Lusitania on 25 Jul 1908, aged 6, according to her declaration of intention to become a US citizen.
Description	<p>Bernice and her sister, Frieda both applied for naturalization as US citizens. They migrated to the US with their mother, Sonie/Sophie. They were bookkeepers. It appears that their father, Samuel/Shelemen, whom their mother married on 18 Feb 1901 in Gomel, Belarus, died prior to their migration.</p> <p>Their grandparents, Aaron and Sarah Bereskin likewise emigrated to the United States and were living together in Chicago according to the 1910 US Census.</p>
Facts	Bernice Delman died on 12 May 1944 according to the Cook County Illinois Death Index. Sonie's naturalization record of 30 Jun 1943 indicates that her name was changed from Sonie to Sophie by court order and that she was born 5 Apr 1881 in Russia.
