No further communication as to their whereabouts.</p> <p>It is believed that this family descend from Stephan Dillmann and his wife Anna Katharina who migrated from Wurzburg in 1766 to the Volga colonies in Russia, as noted by Igor Pleve in his research on Emigrants to the Volga Region, Vol 3. ("Einwanderung in das Wolgagebiet 1764-1767")</p>
