Description	Anthony Dillman and Sybilla/Susanna Kalbach are the known progenitors of the Dillmans of Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania. There has been some early documentation of this family in the county history book, however, not all information has been proven to be correct as is the case for several early 20 th century genealogical texts. Anthony came from Germany, but the exact date is not known. Anthony is likely the Antony Thieleman baptised in Breitscheid, not far from Dillenburg, Germany in 1732.
Facts	Anton Dillman's tombstone in South Manheim Township, Schuylkill County, PA noted that he was born in Dillenberg, Europe 12 Nov 1732 and died 29 Mar 1816 aged 83 years, 4 months and 17 days.
