Date of Immigration	According to the 1900 US Census Georg Adam Diehlmann immigrated to the US in 1854 and was eventually naturalized although neither of these records have been yet located.
Description	Georg Adam Diehlmann was born in Hesse-Darmstadt, Germany on 31 Mar 1831 (as per Find-a-Grave). According to US Censuses for 1870, 1880, 1900, he was a potter by trade and while the family started out in Stark County, Ohio, established themselves in Findlay, Hancock County, Ohio. (Georg) Adam Diehlman enlisted in the 188 <sup>th</sup> Regiment and later moved to the 115 <sup>th</sup> Regiment, Ohio Infantry, Company K, during the US Civil war. He received a pension as in invalid in 1890 and his widow received a widow's pension in Sep 1914.
Facts	(Georg) Adam Dillman was married to Elizabeth Hoffmann in Stark County, Ohio on 6 Dec 1855 (Ohio marriage record). He died on 10 Sep 1914 as per the Ohio Death records.
