	This family continued to live in Butler County, Pennsylvania.
Facts	Philipp Dillmann was born 4 Dec 1806 in Mainz, Rhineland- Palatinate, Germany, baptized the same day, son of Nicholas Dillmann and Helena Christina Schmittbauer.
	Nicolas' marriage record indicates that his father, Jean (a French record) was a merchant/grocer, born and residing at Boppard, Germany and his mother, deceased, Marie Marguerite Bergmann, born at Mieten-sur-Moselle, married Helene Christine Schmittbauer, born in Coblenz, daughter of Michel Schmittbauer, locksmith, born in Stockerau in Lower Austria, and Dorothee Stasser, from here (Mainz). Married on 12 Pluviose year 13 (Republican France dating equating to 31 January 1804)
