Description	Florence was employed by the Magg family to be their nurse and resided in Zurich, Switzerland for many years and when the family decided to relocate to Vermont for a period of time, Florence accompanied them at age 45.
	Florence's father, Charles Delmon, married Mary Mayell on 4 May 1852 and had at least 1 son, Charles Walter, born in 1857 (another, William W was born in 1863). In the 1861 Census, with Charles and Mary was a daughter, Lucy Mayell, born ca 1839, likely the daughter of Mary Mayell by another man. Lucy was listed as a daughter-in-law (step-daughter). In the 1871 Census, Lucy was listed as Lucy Delmon and a daughter of Charles Delmon, her mother, Mary Delmon, having passed away. Then in 1874, Florence was born. Given that Florence looked after Charles Delmon in his declining years, he left his entire estate to her upon his death 9 Feb 1900, not to either of his sons, Charles or William, nor to Florence's mother, Lucy.
Facts	According to her Vermont death record, Florence Annie Delmon was born 14 Nov 1874 in England and died of liver cancer on 3 March 1929, the daughter of Charles Delmon and Lucy Mayell.
