- Rhoda was the executrix of the will.
- appears that there was no jail time
- In 1880, Rhoda appears with her youngest son, Lewis, aged 19.
- Later on, she went by her middle name, Caroline, and resided with her daughter Helen and her family in South Haven, Michigan, where she passed away in 1894.

- Divorce suit was rejected, wife granted sum of \$25 against claim of \$25,000.

To the Honorable Judge of the Probate Court of Hamilton County, Ohio:
The undersigned respectfully represents that he is one of the applicants for a Marriage License, and upon being duly sworn deposes and says that his name is Wilbur Aultman Dillman, that he was 37 years of age on the 17 day of June, A. D. 1918, that his residence is Hotel Gibson - Cincinnati Ohio, that his place of birth was New Philadelphia Ohio, that his occupation is Accountant, that his father's name is Levi M. Dillman, that his mother's maiden name was Mary Ellen Mills and divorced, that the applicant was once previously married, that he is a widower and divorced, and that he has no wife living, that he is not nearer of kin to Nazie L. Nois Southard than second cousin and that there is no legal impediment to his being married, and that he is not an habitual drunkard, epileptic, imbecile or an insane person and is not now under the influence of any intoxicating liquor or narcotic drug.

Wherefore, applicant prays that a Marriage License issue to himself and Nazie L. Nois Southard

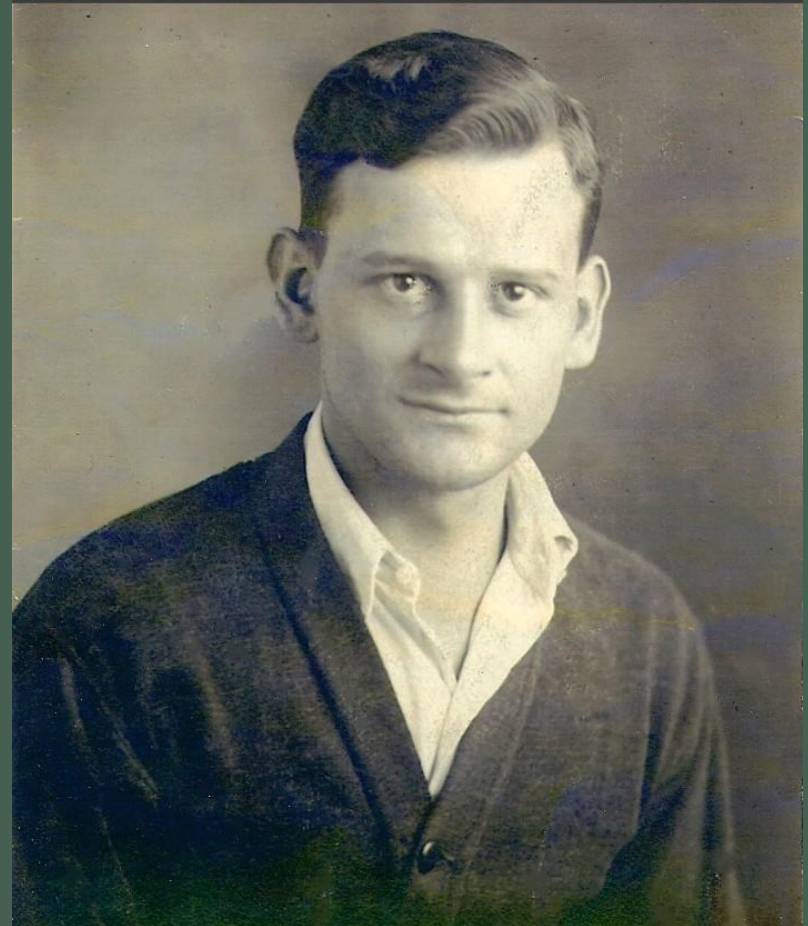
Article 6 – George Robert Dillman

- George Dillman and Miss Emma C. Spencer were married 3 Dec 1903 in Hamilton County, Ohio.
- George was the son of John C. Dillman and Minnie Belle Dalton.
- John C. Dillman died and his widow remarried to Elliot Spencer.
- Hence, Mrs. Elliot Spencer was George's mother, not his "Foster Mother" and certainly not the object of his "attentions".
- George and Emma's first child, Stanley Douglas Dillman, was born 27 Jun 1906.
